- 11/14 Assembly Sq Meeting (100% design)
 - City confirms that the path is still in the design
- 11/14 STEP meeting (Jonah)
 - Wig mentioned an email he sent this morning with a WHO tool for estimating walk & bike health impacts. <u>http://www.heatwalkingcycling.org/</u> We could check it out to help us build our case. He also mentioned a Health Impact Assessment which might be useful for us to reference about the economic benefits of walk/bike. <u>http://ehp03.niehs.nih.gov/home.action</u>

- 11/17 Congressman Capuano's Telephone Community Meetings (Lynn, Alex)
 - Lynn and Alex called in and both made comments pro-path and GLX.
 - Capuano was pro-path and pro-GLX; urged GLX phased approach to start the project
- 11/21 VNA Cedar-to-Lowell 25% Design Hearing and follow-up
 - MAAB letter
 - MBTA felt that they could not build the west stairs without a parallel ADAcompliant ramp. However, there is a parallel route in the MaxWell's Green ramp property throughway.

 - Encroachment was a hot issue at the meeting, and we gave our opinions on it.

- Heather reported on the online version Mayor's Proposed GLX Phasing, from Ward 2 Resistat Presentation; we don't know if this is a proposal or a negotiated plan with the state
 - Summer 2013 Start building first phase of stations at Union Sq, Washington St and Lechmere
 - Early 2014 Start remaining stations
 - 2016 Open first phase stations
 - Winter 2017 Open Maintainence facility
 - June 2018 Complete all stations
